PUBLISHERS' PREFACE.

Bayard Taylor's Centennial Poem is the only work of the kind by a great American poet, designed especially as a Memorial Ode to be used for all time upon all occasions celebrating national events in our American history. Originally delivered by the author in commemoration of the Declaration of American Independence, there has hitherto been lacking an adequate occasion for its presentation to the public at a fitting and favorable time.

The Centennial of the Inauguration of General George Washington as President of the United States enables the publishers to offer Mr. Taylor's great national poem, as a popular souvenir of this memorable anniversary, in a form suitable for permanent preservation.
