THE Colver lectureship is provided by a fund of \$10,000 presented to the University by Mr. and Mrs. Jesse L. Rosenberger of Chicago in memory of Mrs. Rosenberger's father, Charles K. Colver of the class of 1842. The following sentences from the letter accompanying the gift explain the purposes of the foundation:

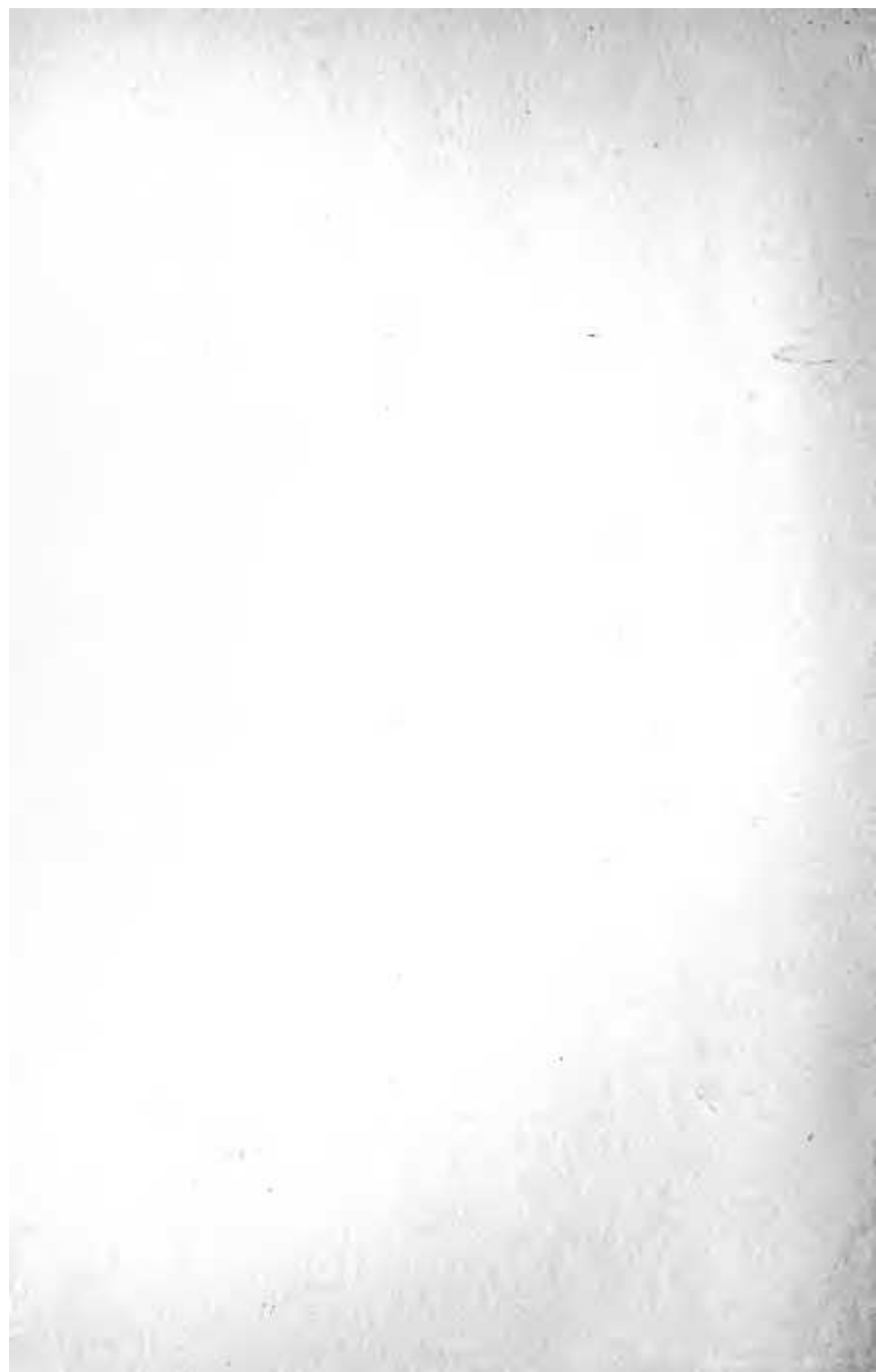

It is desired that the lectures shall be distinctive and valuable contributions to human knowledge, known for their quality rather than their number. Charles Kendrick Colver (1821-1896) was a graduate of Brown University of the class of 1842. The necrologist of the University wrote of him: "He was distinguished for his broad and accurate scholarship, his unswerving personal integrity, championship of truth and obedience to God in his daily life. He was severely simple and unworldly in character."
