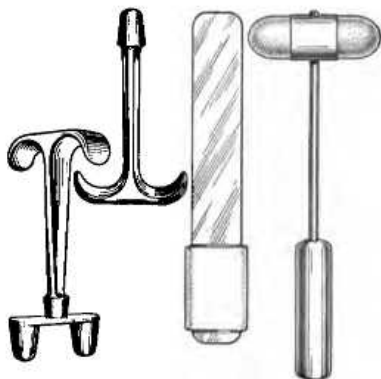

# The President of the National Nut Growers' Association,

*Col. Charles A. Van Duzee*

At the recent Annual Convention, said:

"My own best pecan trees are 8 years of age, having returned more money than the cost of the land, trees, care, fertilizers and interest upon the investment. I value them at ten times the total cost, but I have many other trees that are not so good.

"Two weeks ago I helped to gather the crop from a 22-year old pecan tree, which will pay its own 8 per cent interest upon a valuation of \$2,000 this year. On that basis it has increased in value over \$7 each month for the twenty-two years, and it is not through growing yet.

"The above examples are of the best trees, but there is not a farmer in the entire nut area that may not do as well or better, if he will. The income from a dozen such trees as the last one, would exceed the annual revenue from most farms of a hundred acres, and the labor involved in caring for the trees would not exceed 1 per cent of that of such a farm."

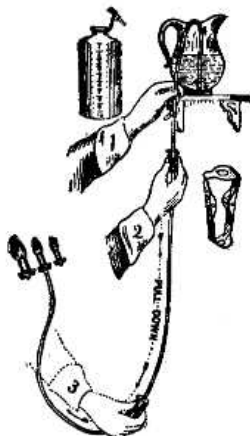
