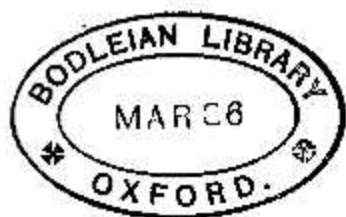

THESE Sermons,—based upon the notes of some Tuesday Evening Addresses delivered in 1881 at my former Curacy of St. Werburgh's, Derby,—were not intended for publication. They were preached on Sunday mornings and evenings during August and September 1885 at St. Paul's Church, Paddington, W. Many members of the congregation having expressed their desire that they should be printed, and the Vicar (the Rev. H. V. H. Cowell) having kindly given his sanction, I have felt it incumbent on me to issue this little Volume. The Sermons are all but unaltered, since their interest (such as it is) depends, I think, upon their being published as preached.
