

HISTORY OF THE GREENWICH SAVINGS BANK.

HE Greenwich Savings Bank was incorporated by an act of the legislature of the State of New York passed April 24, 1833. It was thereby authorized to receive deposits of money, and to invest the same in the bonds or stocks of the United States, of the States of New York, Pennsylvania, and Ohio, and of the city of New York, to loan the same to the Public School Society of New York on real security, and to make temporary deposits in banks in the city of New York. By an act of the legislature passed April 2, 1836, it was also authorized to make loans upon bonds secured by mortgages upon unencumbered real estate situate in the city of New York, worth at least double the amount loaned
