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

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Introduction.

The favor with which the first issue of these tables was received, and the general interest manifested in the subject, have encouraged the compiler to issue a revised edition, bringing the information to the present date, as far as possible.

The first of the following tables contains the names of all places in the United States and Canada in which Water Works are known to be in operation or in course of construction.

These names, 989 in number are arranged in alphabetical order, and the ownership, the date of construction, source and mode of supply, the cost of the works and the names of the principal officers are given.

Two numbers are prefixed to each name, the first one designating its order in the second table, which contains the principal statistics of the condition and operating of the works, and is arranged according to the population of the towns by the U. S. census of 1880, thus enabling the works of towns of nearly the same size to be more readily compased.

The second number is that belonging to the descriptive sketch of the works in "The History and Statistics of American Water Works" which has been in course of publication weekly in *Engineering News* since March 1881.

All of the information given in these tables is derived from special returns made to the author by officers of the works or residents of the towns. There are still 97 towns from which no reply can be obtained.

Since the publication of the first issue, 186 names have been added to the list, and more or less complete information obtained from 290 towns which had not previously replied.

Of the towns which had previously Treplied, 332 have furnished later and fuller statistics of the operation of their works up to the close of their last fiscal year.

The compiler desires to express his thanks to the many persons who have aided him in procuring the information embodied in these tables.

In the compilation and reduction of the statistics, much valuable service has been rendered by Mr. Charles W. Hunt, M. Am. Soc. C. E.
