Preface.

THIS is an attempt to give, in a convenient form, a Book of Reference to Knights made during the periods covered by the Titlepage.

It has been compiled from the most authentic Records available for the purpose, such as the Cotton, Harleian, and Lausdowne MSS.; Hall's Chronicle; Stow's Survey of London; Sir H. A. Nicolas's Orders of Knighthood; the printed books by Philipot and Walkley on the reigns of James I. and Charles I.; and other authorities referred to throughout the Work.

No attempt has been made to annotate further than by way of explaining discrepancies and correcting mistakes; my object has been rather to provide a book for present use, than to delay its production for possibly a lifetime, by the accumulation of genealogical and other notes, the extent of which no one could foresee. *Bis Dat Qui Cità Dat.*

I have endeavoured, by all the means in my power, to render the book complete and accurate, and hope it may prove of some service to those who consult its pages, especially with the aid of the carefully-prepared Index.
