De Vereeniging ter bevordering van de belangen des Boekhandels in Nederland, overtuigd, dat niets zoozeer kan strekken tot ontwikkeling van den boekhandel als bekendheid van zijne artikelen ook in het buitenland, wenscht het hare bij te brengen om den vreemdeling op de Wereld-Tentoonstelling te Philadelphia bekend te maken, met het wetenschappelijk en letterkundig streven in Nederland. Zij zendt daartoe eene, door een aantal uitgevers bijeengebrachte verzameling, oorspronkelijk Nederlandsche boeken, bijna allen van de laatste jaren, door inhoud of uitvoering uitmuntende. Wie echter wenscht de Nederlandsche letterkunde in haren ganschen omvang te leeren kennen, zal die, in de onder No. 6-9 mede tentoongestelde Alfabëtische lijst van Nederlandsche uitgaven, kunnen vinden.

Onder de ingezonden boeken bevindt zich ook eene verzameling van de beste schoolboeken, en eene andere van Nederlandsche tijdschriften en dagbladen. In den Catalogus zijn deze rubrieken onder afzonderlijke hoofden gebracht, en ook verder systematisch in vakken verdeeld, zoodat het den belangstellenden bezoeker gemakkelijk zal vallen een overzicht van de geheele inzending te verkrijgen. De boeken zijn gerangschikt in dezelfde volgorde waarin zij in den Catalogus voorkomen. Het nummer van elk boek is op het schutblad tegenover den titel aangegeven. The Association of Booksellers in the Netherlands is convinced that the best method of extending and promoting the interests of the trade is, to promulgate as much as possible in foreign parts an accurate knowledge of the works issued and dealt in. In furtherance of this object, it has been deemed advisable for the benefit of visitors to the Philadelphia Exhibition, to form a collection of original Dutch books, for the greater part of later date, remarkable for their contents or the form in which they have appeared and sent in by a great number of publishers. Those who wish to become acquainted with Dutch Literature in its fullest extent, are referred to No. 8-9, an alphabetical list of Dutch publications.

Among the works exhibited will be found, too, a collection of the best schoolbooks and of Dutch periodical and daily papers.

In the catalogue these rubrics have been separately and systematically classed, in order to afford an easy and complete oversight of the whole. The books themselves have been arranged and placed according to the order of the catalogue, with some few exceptions, which, on account of their size or form, had to be separately exhibited. Each work is numbered on the sheet opposite the title-page.

In order to give an idea of the current prices of the works, mostly in paper covers, the prices are added to the titles in
