PREFACE.

It is to be regretted that Physical Geography does not obtain that attention from the instructors of youth, which its importance demands; one reason for which may possibly be the want of suitable text-books. Also the publication of a series of maps of Physical Geography, adapted to school purposes, has been long felt to be a desideratum in scholastic literature. It cannot be denied that several excellent physical atlases already exist; but both their size and price preclude their introduction into schools generally. The Messrs. Longman have, however, recently supplied this deficiency by publishing M'Leod's Class-Atlas of Physical Geography, which a somewhat close examination warrants the present writer in characterising as in every respect calculated to give a clear and satisfactory view of the principal phenomena of Nature. In order to facilitate the acquirement of a sound knowledge of, at least, the elements of the subject, the author has prepared a course of questions, amounting to nearly one thousand, expressly adapted to this Atlas, which he here presents to the public. It

will be at once seen that they are arranged promiscuously, which it was thought would prove a better mental exercise than if those on each map had been grouped together. At the same time a reference is appended to each question, as a guide to enable the pupil to find the answer. Of these references some are Arabic numerals, others Roman; the former referring to the Maps, the latter to the pages of the Notes.
