16.—‘All scripture is given by inspiration of God. . . .’

WE should carefully attend to the distinction which there is between the phrase, ‘Holy Scriptures,’ in the 15th verse of this passage, and the phrase, ‘all Scripture,’ in the 16th verse. By the former the Apostle refers chiefly, and almost exclusively, to the Old Testament; but by the word ‘Scripture,’ in the 16th verse, as it is qualified by the word ‘all,’ he refers to every book written under the
