Preface.

At former exhibitions the principle has been observed, that every exhibitor arranged his exhibits by himself, and endeavoured to gain the attention of visitors by a more or less attractive display. In as much, however, as the conditions of space in the Paris exhibition of 1900 have forced the various countries from the beginning to exercise as much restriction as possible, it was evident that a change from previous methods would have to be made and that the collective representation of entire groups of interested parties would have to be organised as far as possible.

Such a group has been formed of the German industry in articles of food; the preliminary arrangements for this purpose as well as its further practical promotion were carried out by a committee which was elected by a meeting of exhibitors at the suggestion of the Imperial Commissioner. The first Mayor of Frankfort o. M. Mr. ADICKES acted as honorary president at this meeting.

The members of the committee are: J. FROMM, Court purveyor, Frankfort o. M., Dr. H. BECKER, sworn legal and commercial analyst, Frankfort o. M., GOTTHARD PABST of the firm of TUERK & PABST, Frankfort o. M.

At the request of this committee, the following gentlemen were elected at a subsequent meeting for the different branches of the industry to form an enlarged board for arranging the preliminary work.

Prof. Dr. von BÜCHKA, as representative of the Imperial Board of Health, Berlin.

Director GREISSL, Munich, as representative of the Brewing Industry.

Mr. HOEFELMAYR, Court purveyor, Kempten (Allg.) as representative of the Dairy Industry.

Mr. KURTZ, Manufacturer, Frankfort o. M. as representative of the Baking Industry.

Dr. LICHTENFELT, Bonn, as representative of the Industry in diætic preparations.

Mr. SCHERER, Kommerzienrath, Langen as representative of the Distilling Industry.

Mr. S. WINTER, Manufacturer, Königsberg (Prussia) as representative of the milling Industry and

Mr. WUCHERER, Court purveyor, Würzburg as representative of the chocolate Industry.

The industries connected with the preserving and conserving of fruits were represented by the members of the committee Mr. FROMM, Court purveyor and Mr. GOTTL. PABST.

German industry owes its great success to the close co-operation of science and practical technics, under a wise social political legislature and to the constant care exercised by the respective authorities. It is by this means that the German Industry in articles of food has been enabled to attain its high and universally acknowledged position on the world's market. In the endeavour to further the final objects, a lively exchange of opinions in circles of scientific and practical work had necessarily to take place; if here and there in other countries people are inclined to make use of public expressions as to the results of investigations into the branch of German articles of food, as a handle for discrediting this industry, such a proceeding is entirely unwarranted, as it does not represent at all the real state of affairs. The object of such publications at the instance of single occurrences is, immediately on their discovery, to bring about a natural purification of the market and it would therefore be wrong to draw general conclusions from them. The German system of investigation in the field of articles of food, ranks, as is well known, as high as that adopted by any country in the world. It has already been developed to such an extent, that it is able to enter into the minutest details in this field; thus, as is but natural, reports can be made on specific details, on the working out of which in many other countries attention has not even been directed.

Apart from every other consideration, the German legislature forces manufacturers for the general welfare and in the interests of the working classes to maintain the utmost cleanliness and to see that healthy hygienic conditions prevail in all parts of the factories.

The German Industry in articles of food has no need to fear any scientific or practical control, and it is therefore specially grateful to the President of the Imperial Board of Health Geheimer Ober-Regierungsrath KOEHLER for delegating, in proof of the above, Regierungsrath Prof. Dr. von BUCHKA to represent the Imperial Government as a member in the enlarged board of our collective exhibition.

For the same reason the exhibits of the Imperial Board of Health as to the system of testing articles of food are in close connection with our collective exhibition.

Unfortunately the small space at our disposal allows but comparatively few firms to participate in the exhibition:— a great number of applications had to be refused. Still the collective exhibition of the German Industry in articles of food will afford expert visitors a good idea of its capabilities.
