



#### LETTER I.

Holman's Hotel—Head Quarters of Fashion—Leave business at home—Mr Holman and his management—Seaair and fish—Lewis's History of Lynn—Nahant mortgaged for £20 sterling.

WE are on the busy move here. The season, although perhaps a little later than usual, so far has opened very favorably. Holman's House is the great head-quarters of fashion, gaiety and enjoyment-and is not only exceedingly well-filled as to numbers, but in all other respects, well. The company of course, is very large; yet they are provided with everything desirable, and there is no reason why they should not enjoy themselves. Notes pass occasionally, and the sweetest notes from the piano and the human voice are often to be heard; but notes to pay are seldom thought of. When people come here they generally leave business affairs behind them, and forget, so far as they may, the trials and perplexities incident to business-life.
