PREFACE.

HE following Pamphlets have been thought worthy of prefervation in a more complete form than any in which they have ever hitherto apppeared. One of them, known as the Cadwalader Pamphlet, has been twice reprinted; first at Trenton, N. J., in 1848, in an inferior style, and not without errors; and again at Philadelphia, in 1856; the latter edition having annexed a feries of forgeries, called the Valley Forge Letters, which threw discredit upon the whole. General Reed's pamphlet, to which Cadwalader's was a reply, has never been reprinted, and is exceedingly scarce. The object of the present edition, which is limited, is to preserve for the historical student as accurate fac fimiles, as careful typography renders possible, of two interesting memorials of the past, the originals of which time and other

causes are rendering scarcer every year. The sew extracts in the Appendix, having relation to the general subject matter of the Pamphlets, are thought proper to be added. Both sides of the controversy are, however, given, and the reader is left to his own conclusions.


