

PRESIDENTS OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS.

Until the adoption of the Revised Constitution, the Governor of the State was exofficio President of the Board. That instrument conferred upon the Regents the power to
clect a President of the University, who should be at afficio President of the Board,
Under this power, the first President was chosen in 1852.
