CHARTER.

LAWS OF NEW YORK, 1865.

CHAPTER 594.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE

“THE UNIVERSITY CLUB”

IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK.

Passed April 28, 1865.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Theodore Woolsey Dwight, George T. Strong, John Taylor Johnston, Charles Astor Bristed, Henry R. Winthrop, Charles F. Chandler, Joseph H. Choate, Edmund Wetmore, Francis E. Kernochan, Eugene Schuyler, Edward Mitchell, Luther M. Jones and Russell Sturges, Jr., and such other persons as are now associated, or may hereafter be associated, with them, are hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of “The University Club,” to be located in the City of New York, for the purpose of the promotion of literature and art, by establishing and maintaining a library, reading-room and gallery of art, and by such other means as shall be expedient and proper for such purpose.
