Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Sin: In compliance with the provisions of section twenty-six, act of May 1, 1876, entitled "An act to carry out the provisions of section twelve, article three, of the Constitution, in relation to the public printing and binding, and the supply of paper therefor," I have the honor to transmit herewith the annual report of this Department, on the finances of the Commonwealth, for the fiscal year ending on the 30th day of November, A.
