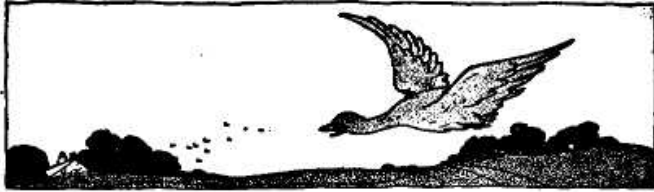

Whose father boldly went a-hunting.

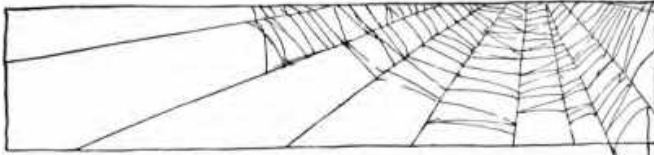
With a rub-a-dub-dub,
