THE CLEMENS FAMILY

In this volume upwards of one hundred different Clemens family lines are represented, including those whose forefathers emigrated from Germany, Holland, England, Wales and Ireland. No complete genealogy of any one particular Clemens line has thus far been printed, and I doubt if any such work has ever been compiled in manuscript. This Chronology therefore will prove to be the basis for such genealogies of the Clemens family which may be compiled in future years by the generations still to come.

All variations of spelling, other than the Clement family, have been included, such as Clemens, Clemmens, Clemmons, Clemins, Clemmons, Clemins, Clemmons, Clemence, Clemense and Clemenz. The name Clement is a distinct one and has no connection with names

without the "t."

As dates are the foundation for all genealogical records, the compiler has purposely omitted a large amount of available material to which were attached neither the year, month, nor day. The fact that John married Mary, or that William was born, with no date accompanying the information, makes the record unreliable and incomplete. Hence the omission of many family records, furnished by numerous members of the Clemens race. These corrected omissions and new data will be inserted in future and enlarged editions of this work. Readers are cordially invited to contribute names and dates for the next edition of the Chronology.
