## PREFACE

Library workers with children know how incessant is the call for "the next book" and how difficult it is to remember the exact sequence of titles in a long series. In order to answer such questions this list was begun with the "List of series and sequels" published by the Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh as a basis. From time to time new titles were added, but by no means all the juvenile series in the market were included — only those which are generally found in the catalogues of children's libraries. There are also listed a few books which are usually found on the adult shelves but which are frequently asked for by older children. It was found that occasionally authorities differed as to the sequence of titles, and in such cases the publishers were consulted and their word taken as final. When a series has been published without a name, one has been sometimes supplied as is indicated by brackets.

An index of the different Series has been added at the end of the book.

It is hoped that the following list will prove to be as great a help and time-saver to other busy children's librarians as it has been to the compiler.
