I.-THE PATRIARCHAL PERIOD.

GENESIS.

CHAP. I.

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the 1 earth was without form and void, and darkness was upon the face of 2 the deep: and the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

And God said, "Let there be light:" and there was light. And 3 God saw the light, that *it was* good: and God divided the light from 4 the darkness. And God called the light Day, and the darkness he 5 called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

And God said, "Let there be a firmament^{*} in the midst of the 6 waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters." And God made 7 the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament : and it was so. And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the 8 morning were the second day.

And God said, "Let the waters under the heaven, be gathered 9 together unto one place, and let the dry *land* appear:" and it was so. And God called the dry *land* Earth, and the gathering together of the 10 waters called he Seas: and God saw that *it was* good. And God said, 11 "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit-tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed *is* in itself, upon the earth:" and it was so. And the earth brought forth grass, and herb 12
