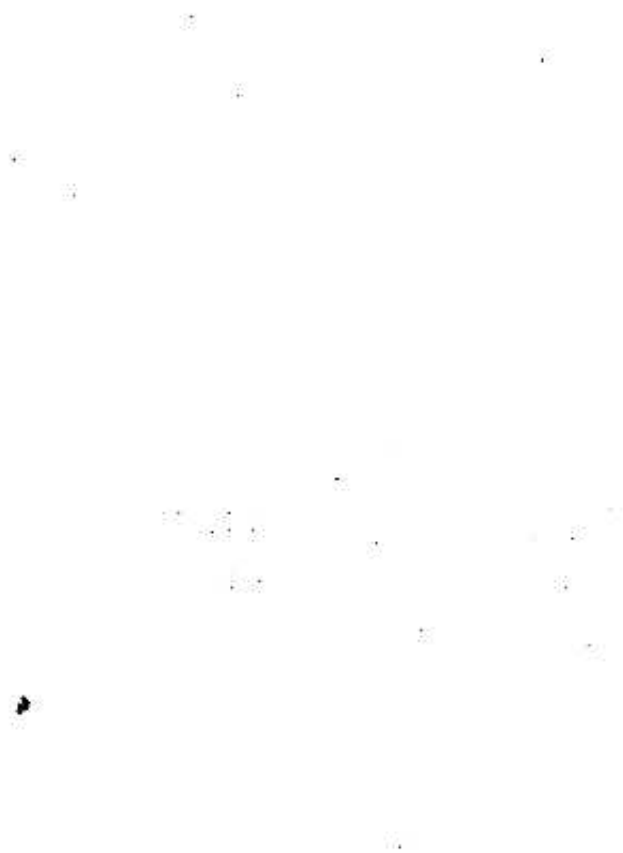
## PREFACE TO THE SECOND EDITION.
