



MAYER FREE LIBRARY.

RULES & REGULATIONS.

1ST.—THE LIBRARY IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, GRATUITOUSLY, ON MONDAY AND FRIDAY EVENINGS, FROM SEVEN TO HALF-PAST EIGHT O'GLOCK, AND ON WEDNESDAY MORNING, FROM TWELVE TO ONE O'CLOCK, EXCEPT CHYSTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY, AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

2ND.—THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH SOOKS ARE LENT FROM THIS LIBRARY ARE, THAT THE BORROWER SHALL FIRST OBTAIN THE SIGNATURES AND ADDRESSES OF TWO HOUSEHOLDERS RESIDENT IN THE PARISH, WHO SHALL GUARANTEE THE SAFE RETURN OF THE BOOK, FREE PROMINIURY, OR BEDOWN RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS VALUE, TOGETHER WITH THE AMOUNT OF AKY PINE THAT MAY HAVE DEEN INGURRED IF KEPT GEYOND THE TIME SPECIFIED; SUCH GUARANTEE TO BE DELIVERED TO THE LIBRARIAN BY THE APPLICANT IN PERSON. IF TWELVE MONTHS SHALL HAVE ELAPSED GETWEEN THE DUE RETURN OF THE BOOK LENT AND THE APPLICATION FOR ANOTHER, THEN A FREGK YDUGHER MUST BE PRODUCED, AS ON THE FIRST APPLICATION. THE LIBRARIAN WILL GAREFULLY EXAMINE, OR CAUSE TO BE EXAMINED, EACH BOOK RETURNED, AND IF THE SAME BE FOUND TO HAVE SUSTAINED ANY DAMAGE OR INJURY, OR HAVE GEEN RENDERED OF LESS VALUE BY BEING SCILED OR WRITTEN IN, THE LIBRARIAN SHALL REQUIRE THE PERSON TO WHOM THE SOOK WAS DELIVERED, OR THE HOUSEHOLDERS ON WHOSE GUARANTEES IT WAS LENT, TO PAY THE AMOUNT OF DAMAGE OR INJURY DOKE, OR CTHERWISE TO PRODUCE A NEW COPY, OF EQUAL VALUE, AND IN THE LATTER 043E, SUCH PERSON SHALL BE ENTITLED TO THE DAMAGED OUPY ON DEPORTING THE NEW ONE.

SRD. ALL APPLICATIONS FOR BOOKS TO BE MADE IN WRITING. "EXCHANGING BOOKS WITH OTHER READERS, OR LENDING THEM TO OTHER PERSONS, STRIGTLY PROHIBITED:" AND NO PERSON IS ALLOWED TO TAKE ANY BOOK PROM THE SHELVES EXCEPT BY PERMISSION OF THE LIBRARY AND SAFETY OF THE BOOKS.

4TH.—THE LIBRARIAN SHALL HAVE A DISCRETIONARY POWER TO RECUSE SOOKS TO ANY APPLICANT NOT OF A SUITABLE AGE TO BE INSTRUSTED WITH THEM, OR TO ANY READER WHO SHALL REQUECT TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES AND REQULATIONS OF THE LIBRARY.

5TH .- REACERS ARE REQUESTED-

TO DELIVER THEIR SOOKS TO THE LIBRARIAN IN THE ORDER IN WHICH THEY ENTER THE LIBRARY.

TO FURNISH A LIST, WITH THEIR NAMES ATTACHED, SPECIFYING THE CLASS LETTER, CATALOGUE NUMBER, AND NAMES OF AT LEAST SIX BOOKS, IN THE ORDER WISHED FOR, TOGETHER WITH THEIR LIBRARY TICKET, AS NO BOOK CAN BE LENT WITHOUT.

TO ENABLE FROM ANY LIST WHIGH HAS BEEN USED BEFORE, BUCH WORKS AS HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY READ, AS BOOKS CANNOT BE CHANGED TWIGE ON THE BAME DAY.

TO REPORT TO THE LIBRARIAN ANY INJURY WHICH HAY OCCUR TO A BOOK WHILE IN THEIR POSSESSION.

TO RETURN EACH BOOK WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TIME (WHICH, IF DESIRED, MAY BE RENEWED, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE LISRARIAN), OTHER-WISE THE READERS SO REDLECTING WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE, WHICH WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

TO USE CLEAN HANDS WHILE READING, AND CAREFULLY AVOID SEMD-INC THE SOCKS BACK OR TURNING DOWN THE LEAVES.

STH.—READERS ARE CAUTIONED AGAINST LOSING THEIR TICKETS, AS THEY ARE HELD RESPONSISHE FOR SOOKS TAKEN OUT OF THE LIBRARY WITH THEIR TICKETS. IF A TICKET SE LOST, IMMEDIATE NOTICE SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE LIBRARIAN. THE TICKETS LOST CAN BE REPLACED AT THE EXPIRATION OF A FORTNIGHT.

7TH.—READERS LEAVING THE NEIGHBOURHOOD, OR CEASING TO USE THE LIBRARY, BHOULD RETURN THEIR TICKETS IN ORDER TO HAVE THEIR GUARANTEES CANCELLED, OTHER-WISE THEY ARM THEIR GUARANTEES WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY SOOK TAKEN OUT IN

STH.—As THE SOOKS ARE INTENDED FOR THE GOOD OF ALL, IT IS EARNESTLY HOPED THAT THE READERS WILL ASSIST THE LISRARIAN IN CARRYING OUT THE FOREGOING REGULATIONS.
