

ADVERTISEMENT.

This Fourteenth Edition of Hill's Arrangement brings the lists down to the Conferences of 1881. Great care has been employed in their preparation, and it is hoped that the result will be satisfactory. Various emendations have been introduced in the designation of Circuits and places, especially on Foreign Stations, with a view to accuracy and uniformity.

The Editor has been again instructed to conform the lists to the stations as printed in the Minutes of Conference; and for this reason he has been unable to adopt some suggested modifications.

Considerable difficulty has been experienced in the case of Probationers, who, having spent one year or more in Circuits, have been sent to the Institution, thereby disappearing from the Minutes for a time, and then returning. In some instances they have not yet returned, and are consequently omitted for the present from the following lists. The Editor has endeavoured to trace these cases by correspondence and otherwise. If any omission or inaccuracy has occurred, he will be glad to be informed, so that the error may be corrected or the omission supplied in a future Edition.
