P R E F A C E.

THE schedule of this small work has been on my hand for many years with the purpose of one day publishing it, but although my object was to give the proper attention required, by the due comparison of the two chapters on their pure grammatical spirit, and not to introduce any scientific points therein, I found, to altogether leave that out which forms the actual object of the two chapters, especially the first, by the introduction of natural law, I have not felt at liberty to carry out this purpose until my discoveries on those roots of Universal Law over Physics were much advanced.
