*Regulations for the use of Books belonging to the  
Taylor Institution.*

---

I. The Professors and Teachers, and all Resident Graduates, and Students of Civil Law, to be allowed the use of Books out of the Library.

II. No person to be allowed to have in his possession at any one time more than Five Volumes.

III. No person to be allowed more than One New Work at a time. Books to be considered New during the year of their publication.

IV. Every person borrowing a Book, to deliver to the Librarian a Voucher containing the Title of the Book, his own Name and College, with the date on which the Book is borrowed.

V. That the Librarian preserve the Vouchers till the Book so taken out be returned to him, entering the same in a Book to be kept for the purpose.

VI. Any person writing in or otherwise damaging a Book to be required to replace it.

VII. All Books to be returned to the Library at the end of each Term. Unbound Numbers of Periodicals and Reviews to be returned at the end of one week.

VIII. If application be made to the Librarian for a Book which has been taken out, the Librarian shall issue Notice to the Borrower to return it within a week from the date of such Notice.

IX. Any person not complying with the above conditions to be liable to be deprived of his privilege.

X. That the following Classes of Books be not allowed to be taken out of the Library :

1. Atlases, and Volumes containing Collections of Prints or Drawings.
2. Biographical and other Dictionaries, Encyclopedias, Catalogues, and Works on Bibliography.
3. The last received Number of each Periodical Work, and Review.
4. MSS. and Books remarkable for scarcity and condition, of which the Librarian has a List.
