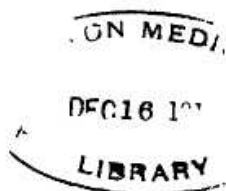

MINUTES
OF THE
MEDICAL ASSOCIATION OF GEORGIA.
THIRTIETH ANNUAL SESSION.
FIRST DAY—MORNING SESSION.

ROME, April 16, 1879.

The Medical Association of Georgia convened this day, at twelve o'clock, in the hall of the Mountain City Fire Company, and was called to order by the retiring President, Dr. William O'Daniel.

The exercises were opened with prayer by Rev. C. A. Evans, D.D., pastor of the First Methodist Church.

Dr. Robert Battey, Chairman of the Committee of Arrangements, delivered the following address of welcome, in behalf of the medical profession of Floyd county:

Mr. President and Gentlemen of the Medical Association of Georgia:

I have been commissioned by my brethren of Floyd county to extend to you our hearty greetings upon the occasion which has assembled your body in our midst. It is now a score of years, save one, since we have been thus honored. Then you saw our little mountain city in the buoyancy of its early growth, reaching out its puny arms with joyous
