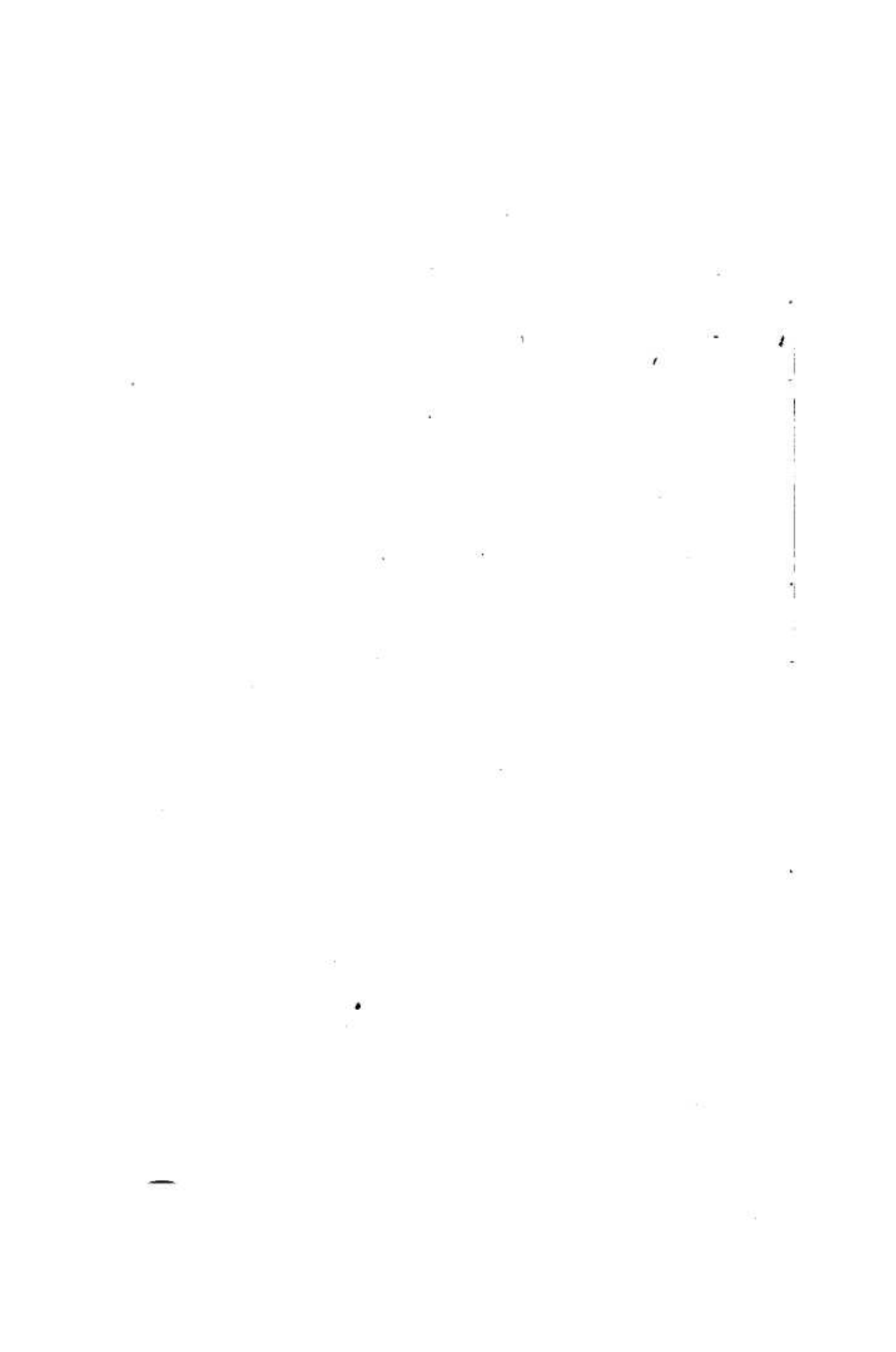

TWENTY-FIFTH ANNUAL MEETING.
